The Haematology Nurse should liaise closely with all Clinicians involved in diagnosis, management and ongoing care of all patients referred to the haematology services. He/she will liaise with other health care professionals involved in patient care within the hospital, with other health care agencies as appropriate and with community services.

### Responsibilities - The post holder will be responsible for;

- Provide specialist knowledge, expertise and care to patients with haematology conditions attending the Mercy University Hospital
- Articulate and demonstrate the concept of nursing specialist practice within the framework of Nursing legislation and the regulatory body of NMBI (Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland)
- Provide safe, comprehensive care for patients and their families within the scope of practice guidelines set out by Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland
- Plan and initiate care and treatment modalities within agreed interdisciplinary protocols to achieve patient/client centred outcomes and evaluate their effectiveness
- Utilise evidence based assessment and treatment skills and techniques to determine and manage each patient/family needs.
