The Chief II GI Physiologist will oversee the efficient and effective running of the Gastrointestinal (GI) Physiology Service in Mercy University Hospital under the direction of the Director of the GI Physiology Unit.

### Responsibilities - The post holder will be responsible for;

- Be responsible for the day to day administration of the GI Function Unit.
- Be responsible for the other technical staff and their clinical workload in the GI Function Unit.
- Be responsible for staff supervision and line- management. These duties will include, but not be limited to implementation of personal development planning, conflict resolution, training needs analysis etc.
