The primary purpose of this post is to provide clinical support to candidate nurses undertaking a period of adaptation in the Mercy University Hospital to gain entry on the register of General Nursing held by the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland NMBI.

The Clinical Facilitator will co-ordinate with the management of Adaptation programmes and will support candidate nurses in collaboration with the clinical ward CNM II to develop skills and competencies in order to fulfill their roles and responsibilities required to register with NMBI.

Responsibilities - The post holder will;

- Be responsible for the assessment of standards of care delivered by candidate nurses who have commenced adaptation in the Mercy University Hospital
- Assist in the preparation and delivery of adaptation programme
- Process candidate NMBI documentation on completion of the programme
- Observe and identify knowledge and clinical experience of staff and promote and encourage reflective practice as a tool for the candidate nurses to demonstrate competence
- Act as a source of clinical expertise for staff within the clinical area
- Ensure that clinical areas provide the optimum learning environment for candidate nurses
- Develop good working relationships with wards and departments to promote quality patient centred care
- Ensure the clinical environment is conducive to supporting the learning and education of all staff

Eligibility Criteria - Candidates:

- Be registered in the General Division of the Register of Nurses kept by the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland NMBI
- Have the clinical, managerial and administrative capacity to properly discharge the functions of the role
- Extensive recent experience in an acute hospital setting including at least 5 years post registration experience in such a setting
- Provide evidence of ongoing professional development
