Responsibilities - *The post holder will be responsible for;*

- Provide a specialist nursing service for the COPD Programme that require support and treatment through the continuum of care
- Practice nursing according to the Code of Professional Conduct and Ethics for Registered Nurses and Midwives (NMBI 2014)

- The promotion of multi-disciplinary team working

Eligibility Criteria - *Candidates:*

- Be registered in the General Division of the Register of Nurses kept by the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland {NMBI}

- Have a level 8 post-registration National Qualifications Authority of Ireland major academic award relevant to the specialist area, or commitment to complete
- Have recent experience with patients with chronic lung difficulties, i.e. a minimum of five years post-registration experience including a minimum of two years experience in the specialist area
- The person must have the ability to practice safely and effectively, fulfilling his/her professional responsibility within his/her scope of practice
- Demonstrate the ability to work with a team and independently
- Full clean driving license with access to own transport and indemnified insurance
- Will demonstrate evidence of a commitment to personal professional development, training and nursing research
- Have an excellent interpersonal and organizational skill and be able to demonstrate a high standard of verbal and written communication skills
