To develop and deliver a Psycho oncology Psychology Service to patients and their families attending Mercy University Hospital, Cork. This includes psychological assessment, formulation and treatment of patients on an individual and group basis, multi-disciplinary working, consultancy, liaison, research, teaching, service design and development of clinical pathways. These duties are to be carried out within professional ethics and hospital policies.

Overview of Responsibilities

- The successful candidate will offer comprehensive psychological assessment, formulation, monitoring, design and implementation of therapeutic interventions for patients with cancer. Innovative approaches to service delivery and therapy, on-going professional development and research will be required. The successful candidate will also undertake accompanying 'systemic' work as appropriate to the case e.g. liaison with multi-disciplinary staff, inter-agency working, multi-disciplinary meetings, consultancy and telephone therapy with patients.
- The role requires an ability to participate in the development and expansion of the service and it is anticipated that sessions will be increased in line with demonstrated need.

Eligibility Criteria

- A postgraduate doctoral qualification in professional psychology with at least three to five years clinical experience is essential. Previous experience of working with cancer patients is desirable.
- Remuneration commensurate with qualifications and experience.
