The Senior Physiotherapist will be responsible for the provision of a high quality person-centred Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation service in the area of Musculoskeletal Care to include other clinical and educational duties as assigned.

Responsibilities - *The post holder will be responsible for;*

- Assess, plan, implement and review treatment and intervention programmes for patients with musculoskeletal complaints in an outpatient setting.
- Collaborate with service users, family, carers, consultant teams, OT and other staff as appropriate in treatment / intervention, planning and provision of services in a coordinated way
- To lead the clinical Physiotherapy rehabilitation of patients with Musculoskeletal and Persistent Pain issues and be a regional resource in conjunction with community settings
- Collaborate with MDT in discharge planning or transfer of care between services as appropriate.
- Other duties as laid down by the Physiotherapy Manager. (See also job description)

- A Bachelor in Physiotherapy (Hons.) or B.Sc. Physiotherapy (Hons) degree from the National University of Ireland or University of Dublin or
- A Diploma in Physiotherapy of the University of Dublin or the National University of Ireland or

- Membership of, or eligibility for membership of the Irish Society of Chartered Physiotherapists
